

## Gianni Mimmo

### Soprano saxophone

Gianni Mimmo has built an international reputation for his unique treatment of musical timbre and his exploration of the advanced techniques on the soprano saxophone. His peculiar work is mainly focused on the relationship among distant artistic declinations and his style is based on a deep knowledge of the instrument and on a sound consciousness

which is the constitutional element of his voice.

Gianni has developed a unique blend of abstract lyricism and contemporary flavours. His projects have been excellently reviewed by international magazines and webzines.



In the last few years some features of his music have shifted to unsuspected directions and his personal curiosity led him to new connections adding some fresh subtleness to his instrumental tone and developing a more compositional attitude to his improvisation.

Cellist, composer, improviser.he has created a unique musical universe, limpid, sensual, melodic and demanding, at the crossroads of contemporary music. ## Thierry Waziniak

#### Drums

«Like "a drum poet in complete command of his instrument" (Orynx- improvandsounds), Thierry Waziniak likes to wander through the worlds of improvised music. Sometimes as part of a large ensemble with Jacques Di Donato and Xavier Charles's Système Friche, or Benjamin Duboc's ensemble Icosikaihenagone. Sometimes in much more intimate formulas, such as the TWIGS drum duo with Didier Lasserre. His singular style of playing, based on control of very low volumes, a relationship with the body and the instant creation of melodic counterpoints, is the fruit of a long creative path that

has crossed paths with some fascinating musicians. (J.Jacques Avenel, Barre Philipps, Michaël Attias, John Hébert, Franz Hautzinger, Isabelle Duthoit, Steve Potts, Jean-Luc Cappozzo..)
